Parsa Wildlife Reserve

Parsa Wildlife Reserve is a protected area in the Inner Terai lowlands of south-central Nepal. Established in 1984, it covers an area of 499 km² in the Parsa, Makwanpur and Bara districts and is the largest wildlife reserve in the country. We can see wild animals very nearly, Elephant safari, jeep drive and jungle walk are available there.

Itinerary:

1st Day: Drive to Kathmandu to amlekhgunj at 07:00 am, Arrival at Amlekhgunj 1:00Pm. take lunch; rest an hour, than evening time Elephant Safari, Dinner and O/N at Resorts.

2nd Day: After breakfast departure to Jeep drive, fullday we are in jungle, lunch at Bhata, see dhugdeshwor mahadev temple, return from Bhata at 3:00 pm, dinner, O/N at Resort.

3rd Day: Early morning jungles walk, after breakfast (if you are student we can Arrange factory visit nearby amlekhgunj) Departure to Kathmandu.

Includes:-Both way transportation by Tata sumo Jeep, Accomodation, elephant Safari, Jeep drives, 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches, 2 dinners.

Not include: personals expanses and bar bills.
